

Field Training Uniform (FTU)

The FTU is Optional Dress. It is not issued to Air Cadets by the Squadron.

Field Training Uniform (C5/FTU). The olive drab environmental training uniform worn by cadets during field training activities.

Composition of the FTU:

1. **Headdress.** The following may be worn: wide-brimmed tan summer hat, beret (Air Force Blue only), toque.

 - b. The headdress insignia (crest) can be obtained from Supply, although quantities may be limited, therefore first come first served.
2. **Field Shirt.**
3. **Rank Slip-ons.** Shall be worn with the FTU. You use your issued ranks.
4. **T-Shirt, Blue.** The t-shirt shall be worn under the FTU.
5. **Field pants and belt.**
6. **Socks.** Grey wool socks may be worn. Cadets may elect to wear their own personal socks, grey or black, wool, cotton or nylon, in lieu of the issued grey wool socks. Socks shall not be rolled down.
7. **Field Boots.** Multi-purpose boots shall be cross laced and kept clean at all times. They may be blackened with boot polish but shall not be shone. (Note from the CO: Hiking boots or other appropriate field footwear is authorized.)

Authorized Accoutrements and Accessories:

- Name tape, optional

Note:

- FTU may be worn under all-season jacket.
- Shirt may be worn with sleeves extended or rolled above the elbows.
- If the beret doesn't have the insignia, no ranks are to be worn.
