## **KIT LIST**

All cadets ***must*** bring the following articles of personal kit:

- Mess Kit (Cup, plate, fork, spoon,) **NO** Glassware.
- Extra Undergarments
- Extra Socks (wool preferred)
- Pair of Pants (**NO jeans** as they soak up 10 times their weight in water)
- T-Shirts
- Ankle High, Warm, Water-Resistant Footwear (**NO running shoes**)
- Rain Gear
- Hat or toque
- Gloves or mitts
- Flashlight, Lip Balm, Sunscreen, Insect Repellent
- Canteen or Water Bottle
- Paper and Pen/Pencil
- Cadet Parka or another warm Civilian Jacket
- FTU Clothing – Cadet Green Uniform

## **FORBIDDEN ITEMS**

- Food or snacks (rations are provided, and improperly stored food attracts animals)
- Make-up, hair styling products, and perfume (attracts insects)
- Personal electronic devices (cellular phones, mp3 players, game systems, etc.)
- Money or valuables
- Alcohol, Drugs, or Tobacco Products

Level 1 and 2 are prohibited to bring a knife. Level 3 may bring a knife; however, it must be a locking folding knife that has a blade no longer than 3 inches; **do not buy one just for this activity**. Level 4 and 5 may bring a fixed blade with proper sheath and must be not longer than 6 inches.

Even though cadets are allowed to bring a knife, all and any staff still has the right to refuse any cadet (no matter rank) from possessing a knife at this activity. Any cadet that acts inappropriately with a knife will have it confiscated and these actions will also result in severe disciplinary action and possible loss of rank. Under the Canadian Criminal Code, prohibited knives include: Any knife, including a switchblade, or butterfly knife with a blade that opens automatically by gravity or centrifugal force or by hand pressure applied to a button, spring or other device in or attached to the handle of the knife.

*Any forbidden items will be confiscated and returned to guardian(s). Cadets in possession of certain items may be sent home or presented to the appropriate authorities.*
